In this direction, the Commission has recently launched a new portal i.e. National Voters' Service Portal (NVSP) which is available at www.nvsp.in. This portal provides all services that may be required by the citizen relating to electoral registration, i.e., online registration, correcting entries or change in address, linking Aadhar no. to the data, searching name on electoral roll besides printing of voter information slip ahead of the poll day.
